

NSCDA in Oregon Patriotic Service Grants Program 2014

Two grants of \$1,000 each will be awarded to middle or high school teachers of American history or a closely related subject in Oregon to enrich classroom teaching.

Proposals should be in one of the following areas:

1. Continuing education related to American history.
2. Curriculum development.
3. Travel and tuition to attend seminars related to American history.
4. Teacher enrichment project or program.

Proposal Form

1. Name
2. Home and email address
3. Name of school and grade or grades currently teaching
4. Principals name
5. Academic history with dates
6. Brief personal history, teaching experience, grants and awards received
7. Explain how the monies will be used including itemized costs
8. Explain how this grant will aid your classroom teaching
9. Briefly state your teaching philosophy

Enclose any brochures or printed material related to your proposal, and a letter of recommendation from your principal or department chair.

Grant applications should be received on or before March 14, 2014. The winners will be notified before April 14, 2014. The grant must be used before February 2015.
